Hello Calvary Lutheran!

The summer is over, Wow! Can you believe it? I guess time really does fly when you're having fun!

Remember last Spring and early Summer when we gathered your preferences for renaming the Old and New Fellowship halls? Well now that the Fall program year has begun we have some updates to share. But first, a brief recap for y'all:

Since the "new" fellowship hall was built in 1995, and we are looking to do renovations to the "old" fellowship hall (making it now the new one?), the Evangelism team, with the input of much of the congregation, believed it was time for a renaming effort.

With full support from the Council, the Evangelism team utilized the spring and summer months to receive feedback from the rest of the congregation on possible names for these two halls. We are happy to say that we finally have those results.

As there was a clear majority preference for each of the following, we are excited to announce that we now lovingly designate these two rooms:

- The Fellowship Hall (formerly New Fellowship Hall) and;
- Mission Hall (formerly Old Fellowship Hall).

Each of these names give a clear expression of the typical activities in each hall. For example, our coffee hour and meals happen in the Fellowship Hall, and our Council meetings, many of our committee meetings, the gathering of goods for community needs, and quilting for Lutheran World Relief all take place in Mission Hall.

It is well understood that this will be a gradual change in language. Evangelism has proposed, and Council has agreed, that we will do this "step by step" beginning this month with changing our language in printed materials and announcements. When signage in the building is eventually changed, then we will take the next step and update these names. And finally, once our renovation is completed in Mission Hall, we will have a more formal dedication of that space and re-dedication of the Fellowship Hall.

Martin Luther said the church reformed, is always reforming. Of course, this is much easier said than done, as change is never easy, but we believe the renaming of our spaces is a wonderful next step in our mutual ministry of always reforming. A step

that will help define who we are together as Calvary Lutheran, both inside and outside our walls for generations to come.

2019 Annual Distribution from the Phoebe Ann Deutschle Memorial Endowment

The Church Council recently voted on the 2019 distribution from the Phoebe Ann Deutschle Memorial Endowment. Due to the continuing generosity of Mr. Deutschle there was up to \$11,750 available this year, up from \$10,000 last year.

Council allocated money for the following needs or uses:

- Support for Vacation Bible School counselors from Lutheridge
- Funding for materials for women's spiritual retreat
- Funding for underwear, socks for Options youth
- Support for the GAL program for foster children
- Funding for equine therapy to help poor kids
- Support for dental care for underprivileged children
- Support for adult leaders at the next ELCA Youth Gathering
- Support for warmth for the homeless
- Support for the Pregnancy Care Center of Burke County
- Support for the SSBD program for young Hispanic women

This year's distribution brings to \$48,245 the total made available to help our church and the community since the distributions began in 2012.
